Innovative Partnership In Action

PA Health and Wellness (PHW) has had a longstanding relationship with CILs across the Commonwealth, partnering to facilitate transitions out of nursing homes and to educate service coordinators and health plan support teams on the Independent Living Philosophy. CILs are involved in the transition planning process, attend face to face care team. meetings to advocate for and support participants, and work directly with the health plan to address and resolve issues. In coordination with the CIL transition support, PHW successfully transitioned over 456 individuals from nursing facilities with less than a 4% recidivism rate.



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
